TEST PITS/SEPTIC SYSTEM REVIEW FORM

Adopted July 26, 2004
Revised May 7, 2008

Septic systems are required for any expansion of living space, an increase in ridge line, expansion of foot print, demo, new house, and to replace failed systems (unless a replace-in-kind is considered).

Applicant shall hire a septic designer and back hoe operator to dig the test pits and design the system.

The town's consultant, Dennis Plante, will witness the test pits and review the design for compliance with the Town regulations/building code prior to sending to the State for review. The designer will coordinate directly with Dennis Plante for scheduling.

Four sets of completed plans shall be delivered to the Building Department Office with a stamped envelope to be mailed to the State. Three will be mailed to the State and one will be retained in the office.

A building permit is required for the installation of the system.
