

RYE CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Site Walk Minutes

Wednesday, September 9, 2020

Meeting was called to order by Chair McFarland at 12:30 pm.

RCC members present at the site walk: Chair Suzanne McFarland; Members Susan Shepcaro, Mike Garvan, Jaci Grote and Heather Reed.

12:30 pm: 112 Perkins Road, Tax Map 52 Lot 117, Owner: Melissa & Kevin Janvrin

Present: Kevin & Melissa Janvrin.

The Rye Conservation Commission (RCC) conducted a site walk at 112 Perkins Road to look at the completed project on the property to see if the ZBA conditions had been met. Kevin Janvrin showed the commission the plantings that had been established. There were blueberry bushes planted all along the lawn/wetland edge. A gravel drip edge has been installed on the wetland side of the house. The silt sock has been left in place which will keep some of the invasives in the wetland from encroaching onto the lawn. Sod was used to establish the lawn to minimize erosion. The Janvrins will use slow release lime and have not added fertilizer to their lawn.

Kevin Janvrin asked if they could remove branches from a tree in the wetland that are overhanging their lawn. The RCC told him that was permitted by the ordinances.

The project followed the recommendations of the RCC and the requirements of the ZBA. The RCC recommended that a Certificate of Occupancy be issued.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:45 pm by Chair McFarland.
