Purpose: Discuss potential demolition of 2257 Ocean Boulevard Proposed Plan: Tear down and replace with modular home

Unanimous vote that the property is NOT significant.

- D. Choate will notify the Building Inspector, Peter Rowell, and Kate Drago of our decision.
- D. Choate said the Demolition Review Ordinance revisions will be on the March ballot as previously discussed. The Planning Board moved the changes on to the warrant for a March vote. Some of the proposed changes are:
 - 1. Add another Alternate member to the Committee so we will have 3 Members and 3 Alternates.
 - 2. Add monuments, statues and memorials to Committee review.
 - 3. Add "in part or whole" as a demolition review standard.
 - 4. Move the first required meeting from 5 business days to 10 business days.
 - 5. The demo permit will be the last one issued.

The Board of Selectmen has asked the Committee for its goals, objectives, procedures and mission statement for 2020:

- 1. The Committee meets as needed and a quorum is 2/3 Members or Alternates.
- 2. The Committee's mission statement is in the ordinance.
- 3. Objectives for 2020:
 - a. To become more proactive by submitting an article to Rye Magazine (Alex will prepare a draft for Committee review).
 - b. Use Rye Day (September 27) to promote the Committee.
 - c. Identify two individuals to serve on the Committee as Alternates.

A. Herlihy motioned to adjourn.

E Sanborn seconded the motion.
