Solar at Major Consuming Municipal Locations - Howard and Tom met with Mike Magnant and talked about the fact that we could end up with a number of solar panels as a result of Thursday's program: ReVision Energy will donate a solar panel to the town for every residential solar installation that is made. The panels would include all hardware and installation. Howard, Tom and Mike are still looking at other locations, include a solar array on the ground. Tom and Howard will present a draft of an RFP to the Board of Selectmen to review. The intent would be to obtain a suitable provider for installation.
