Application to Cut Trees Along Scenic Road

The Rye Planning Board will hold a public hearing at 7:00p.m. on Tuesday, April 11, 2017 pursuant to RSA 231:158 on the application of Eversource Energy to trim and remove trees and brush adjacent to and beneath some of its power lines within town. All roads have been designated a scenic road by the Rye Town Meeting. The work is necessary to insure the safe distribution of power and to improve the reliability of electric service for. The work to be done will occur along various roads and streets.

Trees which present a threat to Eversource lines or other equipment because of decay or other defect will be removed on a case by case basis. A list of "risk" trees identified for possible removal are available for viewing on a plan and they are marked with a blue and white checkered ribbon. Plans are available for inspection at the town offices.

The hearing will be held at the Rye Junior High School on Washington Road. The application to cut trees along a scenic road may be inspected at the planning office at the Rye Town Hall.
