3. Review in general the overall layout, and specifically options discussed in prior years, and formulate ideas for subcommittees, further discussion new warrant article for additional funding (2025 or 2026 perhaps), etc.
  - a. Crosswalks using brick pavers vs. asphalt (or other materials). Budget related
  - b. Benches (Park Benches) and locations. Where and how do we want?
  - c. Pocket parks. Locations
  - d. Landscape plantings.
  - e. Additional street lighting.
  - f. Style of street lighting.
  - g. Signage - style and color. See attached sample.

The above (a thru g) is for forward thinking; we will not resolve any of the above in one discussion. Also, once the engineering firm is contracted, and they designate the landscape architect, we will then be able to inject our thoughts. That will be down the road, so to speak.

OTHER ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION WHICH PROBABLY FALL OUTSIDE OF TAP GRANT MONIES:

- h. additional pavement needed for bike lanes, road changes, etc.
- i. study of intersections at Washington & Central, and Washington & Wallis.
- j. Further work on the Town Offices Annex.
- k. Sod for TAP Grant project.
- l. Irrigation system for Rye Town Center.
- m. Contracted lawn and shrub maintenance for Rye Town Center.
- n. Interaction with Rye Public Library regarding Library Common. Could the Town become a stakeholder and help raise money?

The above (h thru m) are also items open for discussion that will ultimately affect the Rye Town Center look and feel.

4. Further discussion about Lang Road intersection with Washington Road. While up to the engineering firm to come up with the optimum layout, we are not precluded from making observations as denizens and submitting to the engineering firm.
5. Intersections at Washington & Central and Washington & Wallis. Most likely this will be an extra cost for the town as the TAP will not cover much in terms of ideas outside the TAP Grant. There is some overlap, and so discussion is warranted.
