The purpose of the hearing is to consider acceptance and expenditure of up to twenty-seven thousand four hundred eighty-two dollars (\$27,482.00) grant funding from the State of NH Department of Safety for the purpose of reimbursement of 50% of the costs to equip the Police Department with body-worn cameras and cruisers with dashboard cameras as well as the ongoing costs of maintenance and storage of data recorded by body-worn and dashboard cameras.
