

Emergency Notification System | Emergency Services, Communications, and Management | NH Department of Safety

Rye contracted with the State of New Hampshire emergency notification system known as "NH-ENS". The purpose of the system is to allow rapid and efficient communications during natural and/or man-made disasters. NH-ENS is a name for the automated computer system that provides the State with both a multi-line telephone messaging system and an on-demand emergency alert warning system. Outbound messages can be broadcast for voice, text messaging and e-mail. The system is an emergency service listing data base which provides an updated listing of all E9-1-1 customers in the State of New Hampshire. The NH-ENS alert system allows community users the capability to rapidly notify citizens of emergencies in their communities. The system can also send a "blast out message" to all cell phones in a certain area near a cell tower.
