

Rye Telecommunications Infrastructure Committee Charge

The committee is charged with developing a plan to investigate and identify types of telecommunications infrastructure which will eliminate basic text and voice cellular dead spots throughout the Town of Rye. The plan will identify and rank potential locations for such infrastructure, listing pros and cons and identifying specific town actions that will ease the burden for infrastructure approvals, deployment and maintenance. The committee will be assisted by a telecommunications consultant hired by the town.

The Committee will consist of not more than five members and shall be appointed by the Board of Selectmen for an initial term ending on March 31, 2020. The committee will present their recommendations at a Selectmen's meeting. Staff members may be appointed as non-voting members of the committee. It is the Selectmen's intent to sunset this committee after completion of its charge, unless the Selectmen vote to continue the committee.

The Rye Telecommunications Infrastructure Committee shall follow the Rules of Procedure for Committees established by the Board of Selectmen.


